Martin is vice president and global head of Adient's premium brand Recaro Automotive Seating. He leads the complete automotive branch of Recaro and is responsible for the passenger car seat business. He joined Adient in September 2017.

After receiving his master's degree in Economics from the University in Bonn, Martin joined Daimler-Benz AG in 1991. Starting as an Executive Assistant he later held leadership positions in M&A and strategic projects before working on turning the single-brand dealer network of Mercedes-Benz into a multi-brand organization after the merger with Chrysler. Later he was oversaw the sales strategy for Daimler's world-wide truck operation. Martin Klein then moved to the USA supporting a major turn-around program for Freightliner before leading and reorganizing the world-wide sales organization for Mercedes-Benz Special Trucks. In his final assignment for Daimler Martin served as the Director of a Mercedes-Benz branch in Germany.

After 25 years he left Daimler to join a privately held German Investment Company.

Martin C. Klein has deep personal automotive roots: his grandfather worked as an assembler for speedometers, his father was an executive for an automotive tier 1 supplier and his uncle was selling Porsche sports cars. Heading Recaro Automotive Seating for him is an honor and an obligation at the same time carrying the torch for such an iconic brand.
